

## Watering Route Suggestions

Looking for some suggestions on how to best travel around town to water beds that need attention on the weekends? Here's one route that tries to minimize making too many duplicate turns. Having the watering map handy will help.

East on State to Bed # 2, then...

East on State to Bed # 1

West on State to Bed # 3

West on State to Bed # 8

West on State to 4<sup>th</sup> St. Beds # 37, # 32 and # 45. Turn North on 4<sup>th</sup> and park truck between corner and entrance to parking lot, then...

North on 4<sup>th</sup> to Hamilton. East on Hamilton to between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> for Bed # 20.

East on Hamilton to 2<sup>nd</sup>. South on 2<sup>nd</sup> to State. West on State to 3<sup>rd</sup>. South on 3<sup>rd</sup> to Post Office. Beds # 31A, # 31B, # 31C, # 31D and #31E.

West on James to Olive Mill. Bed # 43.

West on James to 4<sup>th</sup>. North on 4<sup>th</sup> to State. Park in the turn lane onto State. Tubs # 38.

East on State to 1<sup>st</sup>. South on 1<sup>st</sup>. Park in parking lot to water Bed # 10.

Pull out of parking lot onto South bound 1<sup>st</sup> and park in front of City Hall. Beds # 44C, # 44D and # 44E.

West on James. Park at curb water 2 tubs, # 44A.

West on James to 3<sup>rd</sup>. South on 3<sup>rd</sup> to Fulton. West on Fulton to parking lot entrance on North side of Fulton. Bed # 39.

Fulton West to 7<sup>th</sup>. South on 7<sup>th</sup> to South. West on South St. to PW

We used 400-450 gallons of water which means a refill of the tank at PW sometime during your efforts. About 2 ½ hours for two people.
